The NATO School Oberammergau (NSO) Advanced Distributed Learning (ADL) office supports modern training methods and develops online courses to prepare resident course participants and NSO staff to use emerging concepts and capabilities for joint, multinational and inter-agency operations world-wide.

## **NSO's eLearning Programme**

The Programme focuses on a three level approach:

### **Foundation Courses**

support NSO's resident courses and aim to bring students to a common knowledge level

### **Learning Enhancement Courses**

offer broader NATO topics of interest as well as professional development subjects

### **NATO / PfP Online Courses**

support NATO and the partner communities on various topics such as Introduction to NATO. These courses are developed by the NSO ADL office and other NATO and Partner Training & Education Facilities.

## NATO eLearning Instructional Design Course

The NSO ADL office offers resident training conducting the “NATO eLearning Instructional Design Course” (M7-126) twice a year. The course aim is to provide participants with the basic knowledge required to create eLearning products. Furthermore, the students will learn how to implement and evaluate eLearning solutions in support of NATO Education and individual training activities. The two-week resident course is accompanied by an additional week of online instruction that will introduce students to the possibilities of online tutoring and online teaching.

## NSO Members' Portal / GlobalNET

ADL trains and supports the online communities of practice hosted on the NSO Members' Portal. The portal is an online collaborative environment, which enables interactivity and allows members to create and find information. Additionally, NSO Course Directors use the portal to support their students' course preparation by offering online read-ahead packages and exercise scenarios.
